The FIVE ASSEMBLY SONGS are:

- 1. The Recycling Song (A bright and upbeat song all about the benefits of recycling)
- 2. The Thank You Song (A song to celebrate the good things in our world)
- 3. The 999 Song (A bright and light song all about what an important role the four emergency services play in our lives)
- 4. The Harvest Song (A song that says thank you to farmers for the annual harvest)
- 5. Lead by Example (This jazzy song implores adults to try and be more caring and lead by example)

The FIVE VOCAL WARM-UPS are:

- 1. Nursery Rhyme Time (Three traditional Nursery Rhymes arranged so that they can all be sung at the same time)
- 2. Buzz, Buzzy Bee (A round all about a Buzzy Bee)
- 3. One, Deux, Zehn (This round teaches the singers how to count from one to ten in English, French, German, and BSL)
- 4. It's all a bit Cheesy (Nothing more to say other than it's a very cheesy round)
- 5. Cutie Canines (What's your favourite dog breed? Does it manage to poke its nose into this piece?)

The FIVE SONGS WITH TUNED PERCUSSION are:

- 1. There's a Bee in my Bedroom (Uses the notes BEE and BED on tuned percussion)
- 2. Hungry (Uses the notes FEED and FED on tuned percussion)
- 3. Veruca Salt (Uses the notes BAD and EGG on tuned percussion
- 4. What's in your Bag? (Uses the notes EGG, BAG, BEEF, CABBAGE, on tuned percussion)
- 5. Friends (Uses the notes FAB, BAD, ACE, FACE on tuned percussion
